### Life Cycle

Footwear should be stored in their original packaging, kept in a controlled stock area, not subject to rapid changes in temperature or humidity levels.

### Care Instructions

After use leave your footwear to dry in an aired place away from heat. Remove any excess dust or dirt with a brush. Remove any marks using a damp cloth and soap if necessary. Finally polish any grain or pigmented leathers using a commercially available shoe care product.
